



How to Apply for Medicaid

Virginians must meet specific income thresholds and/or other eligibility criteria before qualifying to receive Medicaid benefits. There are multiple ways to apply:

- Call 833-5CALLVA (833-522-5582) and they will direct you to the best place for assistance.
 - You can also call 888-221-1590 (TDD).
 - If you are applying for additional benefits such as the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), call the Enterprise Call Center at **855-635-1370**.
- Apply online at CommonHelp: commonhelp.virginia.gov
 - Or apply online at the Health Insurance Marketplace: marketplace.virginia.gov
- Mail, fax, or drop off a paper application to the local Department of Social Services.
