## **DMAS Legislative Role**

- DMAS is an Executive Branch Agency within the Health and Human Resources Secretariat
- DMAS coordinates legislative interactions with HHR Secretary and Governor's staff to align with Governor priorities
- DMAS' legislative staff are available to assist you with legislative and policy technical assistance and constituent assistance.



#### **DMAS Legislative Role**

- Monitor introduced legislation
- Review legislation and budget language for Secretary and Governor.
- Make position recommendations to Secretary and Governor
- Communicate Governor's positions to General Assembly
- Provide expert testimony and technical assistance to legislators on legislation
- Assist the Secretary and Governor in developing the Governor's introduced budget
- Work with Senate Finance and House Appropriations staff to provide technical assistance on budget amendments



## **Medicaid Related Legislation Development**

- Common types of legislation/budget amendments
  - Changing eligibility criteria for a specific population
  - Covering a new benefit or service
  - Requiring a study or report on a new initiative or ongoing operation
  - Expanding an existing service
  - Changes to provider reimbursement rates



## **Medicaid Related Legislation Development**

- Questions to assist you when developing legislation or budget amendments regarding Medicaid:
  - Does this require a legislative solution?
  - Does this require both state and federal authority (YES!)
  - Will there be a budget impact?
  - What operational changes will be required, particularly on state IT systems?
  - Will it require contract changes with managed care organizations?
